## 8:00-Sunrise Service

The Worship Service will be at 8:00 so we can enjoy the sunrise of Easter Sunday.

The 29th Annual Farm Tour in Hendry County is slated for Thursday March 18th, 2010. The event is hosted by The Hendry County Farm-City Tour Council. Tickets are \$60 per person and the participants will be able to catch a modern air-conditioned tour bus at the Hendry County Extension Office in LaBelle. Hendry County is one of the largest agricultural counties in the state. It is one of the largest orange producers in Florida with more than 75,000 acres of groves. In the state, it's also the second largest producer of sugarcane and third largest producer of vegetables. It's the fifth largest in beef cattle. This year's tour will include visits to vegetable transplant and ornamental nurseries, citrus, sod, sugarcane and vegetable fields, and one of the largest beef cattle ranches in the state. There will be fresh Florida orange juice breaks along the way and a steak lunch with all the trimmings served by the Hendry County Cattlemen's Association in a rural, county setting.
