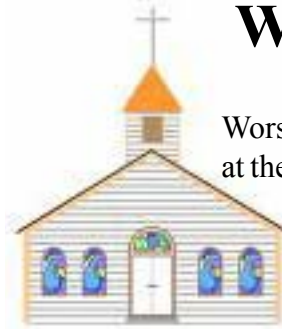


## Golf Course

We have great things planned this season, so sit back and enjoy!! We pray you all have a GREAT season! You will be able to keep up with all the news and activities through the Weekly Resort Report and Calendar. It will be available every Monday morning by 11:00 in the Office, Grill, and Clubhouse.

Below are listed some of the major improvements underway that began during the summer:

The unsightly rocks that were in front of the Grill have been removed and the area prepared for landscaping. In addition an area south of the Grill deck has been

filled and levelled for a croquet court. The grow-in of grass is currently underway. Landscaping should be completed by Christmas.

The original Wastewater Plant that was located near the River Haven Clubhouse parking lot has been removed. The lift-station that once pumped into the plant has been connected to a man-hole that continues the flow to the large wastewater plant across the canal near the Rodeo Arena. Many trees were removed and transplanted and the area is currently being finish graded. Grass will then be planted and the area will now be "River Haven Park." In the future a large picnic shelter will be built in this area which will remain a "green area" for activities and pets.

A new club house is currently under construction in Golf Haven between the swimming pool and comfort station. The interior of this building will measure 50' by 80' and include a large activity area, restrooms, utility room, and warming kitchen. On the east side, facing the pool, there will be a 20' by 62' porch to provide shade for pool guests. Down each side will be a 6' covered walk. The building is of steel construction and should be completed around the first of the year. There are also plans for a play area in the yard north of the new clubhouse which will include picnic shelters with grills, volleyball court, tennis/basketball court, etc.

A new pole barn is under construction across the canal near the maintenance shop. This 36' by 100' building is being built by staff and volunteers and will house equipment and supplies. Anyone who likes to swing a hammer is welcome to join the fun!

## Bal-Gas Delivery Day Change

As an amenity to guests in the Resort, the Bal-Gas company is contracted to provide on-site propane tank refill service for propane gas tanks. During the month of November this service will be provided on alternate Wednesdays beginning November 3rd. Please be sure to sign the sheet at the office if you are in need of propane gas. Payment is required at the time of the service to the Bal-Gas company representative. If you are unable to be present at your site when the representative is scheduled, please arrange with Dora for payment and service.
