Fishing with the Preacher . . .

Those interested in fishing may find helpful this monthly contribution by Bro. Jackie Miller, Minister of Clewiston First Christian Church. If you would like to speak with Bro. Jackie personally about the fishing opportunities in the area please see Dora in the Office. She can give you the contact information for her Dad.

JACK PHILLIPS & I brought back 14 - 7 Reds, 5 Blue Gill, and 2 Bass from the Discharge Canal. We brought back 26, 2 Specs, and 24 Blue Gill, Warmouth and Pumpkin Seeds from Uncle Joe's Cut, all caught on jigs and beetle spins. WALTER GILBERT & a buddy brought back 49 big Blue Gill and Shell Crackers from the rim canal, caught on crickets. JOE PAYNE has had some great days with clients Bass fishing. On a very windy day they caught around 45 - 1-9+ pounder & 2-7+ pounders in their catch on shiners. JACK PHILLIPS & I went to Ole' Sportsman's Village Canal on a windy day. We brought back 37 - 3 Specs & 34 big Blue Gills all caught on beetle spins. We also caught over 25 Bass up to 16" in length, and a few smaller Specs and Blue Gill that we threw back. Jack went back to the same place the next day and caught 30 more Blue Gill and several Specs on beetle-spins. BOBBY & MARVIN MILLER have been bringing in 30-40 big Blue Gills each time they go out. ROGER OSBORNE & I brought back 16 - 7 nice Specs and 9 Warmouth & Blue Gills, fishing with jigs & beetle spins. I went with WALTER GILBERT and we fished in Fish Eating Creek. Walter used crickets for the most part and I used a jig & beetle spin. We brought back 60, big Blue Gill, Warmouth and Specs. We turned back several Specs just under 10" and some Bass and Blue Gill. I went over to "The Glades" to take VINCE DOBLER his "March with the Master" sheet. He & PEG recently moved there. While I was there, my daughter DORA took me by the RV of GEORGE & GEORGIA HOUCK. They had just gotten back from Lake Tifford and had a limit of 50 Specs caught on minnows! They went back a couple of days later and caught their limit (50) of Specs again plus a 20" Bass! JOE PAYNE has been having some great days Bass fishing with his clients. He and his clients recently had 7, 5 and 4 pounders in their catch and catching 40 or 50 a day at times. JACK PHILLIPS reported that he caught "50" and "40" Blue Gill and Specs at Ole' Sportsman's Village Canal in two trips and "42" here on one trip. I went with WALTER GILBERT over to Lake Trafford and we brought back "40" - 38 Specs and 2 Blue Gill, caught mostly on jigs. Walt caught a few on minnows. We threw back many small ones and the ones we kept were medium size. MORRIS GARNER reported that he caught 2 limits of Specs in the rim canal in two trips. WALTER GILBERT reported he caught 47 big Blue Gill in the rim canal on crickets in a couple of hours. I took JACK PHILLIPS down the rim canal last Friday. We brought back a 5-gallon bucket full and running over! We had 12 nice Specs, 1-19" Bass and around 60 big Blue Gill & Shell Crackers caught on jigs, beetle spins and live grass shrimp. The lake is at 11.64' and falling.
