Propane Gas Update

As an amenity to guests in the Resort, the Bal-Gas company is contracted to provide on-site propane tank refill service for propane gas tanks. Service is provided every Wednesday. Please be sure to sign the sheet at the office if you are in need of propane gas. Payment is required at the time of the service to the BAL-Gas company representative. If you are unable to be present at your site when the representative is scheduled, please arrange with Dora for payment and service. There has been a price increase of \$1.00 per tank and/or 16 cents per gallon beginning this year. 20lb bottles are \$16, 30lb bottles are \$24, 40lb bottles are \$28. Per gallon price is \$3.16.
