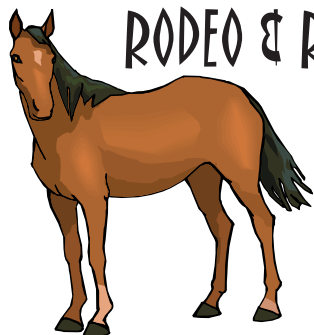
ARTISTS ON SITE
